


Henry Budd College Emblem




Heart

The Canterbury Cross with four red hearts symbolizes the love of Christ in the four Gospels and our love of God in heart, mind, soul and strength.




Four Directions

- ... develop material for theological education and study groups in Indigenous parishes.



Diploma in Theology

- ❑ relating Christian tradition to one's own culture & spirituality
- ❑ students not already immersed in their own language and culture will require elective courses



Masters of Divinity

- ❑ Vancouver School of Theology
- ❑ summer school and extension courses taught in the home community
- ❑ based on competencies rather than credits
- ❑ may complete this program in 4–6 years



How are we helping?
